HSL railway service to and from Breda to start in April



On 4th April 2011 the Fyra high speed trains will run to Breda. This brings Amsterdam and Breda together at a little more than one hour's travelling. With Breda's link to the High Speed network there will be a high-quality connection between

Brabant and the Randstad conurbation enabling customers to travel fast and comfortably.

Without having to change trains, travellers using the high speed link can gain a minimum of 35 minutes on their travelling time. This brings people closer together and enables them to use their time more efficiently.

Comfortable

Fyra uses comfortable intercity trains. Seats are bookable and there is catering on board.

Even this year Fyra will also run twice an hour at weekends between Amsterdam and Rotterdam. So far this only happened on work days. By increasing the frequency at the weekend it is made more attractive for customers to use Fyra at the weekend as well.

More often to Paris by Thalys

Since December 2010 Thalys increases the frequency of the number of trains between Amsterdam and Paris. It will then be possible to travel between the Dutch and French capitals ten times a day. Since Thalys uses the HSL the number of possibilities to travel has this year increased from 7 to 10 train rides a day. For customers the considerably shorter travelling time (3 hours and 18 minutes) appears to be an important reason to choose to go by Thalys.

Breda aspires to establish new WTC-linked International Business Club



The City of Breda wishes to strengthen its international position in the next few years. Of course, this is inspired by its ambition to remain an attractive business location for companies from all over the world, but also and especially by its ambition to actively connect international companies with the city and with each other. Furthermore, the City wants to create more places and networks which bring together not only international entrepreneurs but also expats and internationally oriented educational institutes, for example.

In the new development of the WTC the City of Breda envisions its ideal to realise this meeting point. A place where international business from Breda and its environs may gather for a networking meeting or social get-together, but also a place which serves to make presentations, have workshops and do business. The club will be not only a business network for international companies, but also for Dutch companies (wanting) to do business internationally.

The City of Breda has entered talks with the WTC developer, IPMMC Property Development, about how to set up the network. The plans are for the WTC to be surrendered together with the new Public Transport terminal mid 2014. The International Business Club is to start its activities before this date.
